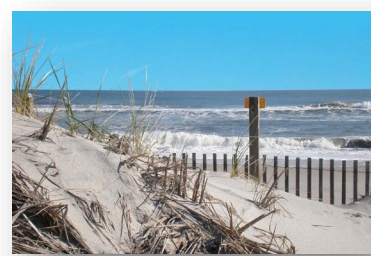

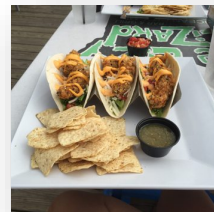


Company and Location:

- **Company** – Waterfront venue, family friendly, outdoor dining with regular live entertainment.
- **Community** – Atlantic resort town, year round population of about 7000, hosting 8 million + visitors annually!
- **Location** – Part of a barrier island on the East Coast of Maryland. About 150 miles (241 km) SE of Washington, D.C. and 240 miles (386 km) S of New York City.
- **Weather** – Hot during the day, warm during the evening. Average temperatures range between 75 and 100 degrees Fahrenheit (23-38 degrees Celsius)

Job Position:

- **Busser (\$3.63 + tips)** – assist servers with cleaning, setting, and clearing tables.
- **Dishwasher (\$11.75)** – wash pots, pans, dishes, keep back of house clean and safe.
- **Expo (\$11.75)** – make sure orders are cooked in a timely fashion and at the same time as the rest of the order, make sure it gets served to the table.
- **Host (\$11.75)** – Welcome and seat guests, answer general questions.
- **Kitchen Worker (\$11.75)** – assist in hot, fast paced kitchen.
- **Runner (3.63 + tips)** – serve food from kitchen to table. Learn and understand restaurant menu, layout, and kitchen.
- **Server (\$3.63 + tips)** – Greet customers, take orders, bring food and drinks to the table, answer questions. *All positions require standing for the duration of your shift, general restaurant duties as assigned & cleaning safely with chemicals!*
- **Hours** – Average 32+ hours per week
- **Start Date:** May 15 – May 21, June 15 – June 21
- **End Date:** DS End Date



Employment Conditions:

- Advanced English skills for interacting with customers with a positive attitude.
- The first 3 weeks will be a training period where the hours may be reduced until you are immersed in your full time schedule. Hours will be 32+ average over the course of the program.
- Hours and schedule will vary each week, must be available and able to work holidays, weekdays, and weekends (Saturday, Sunday) as scheduled.
- **Uniform** – Reviewed upon arrival. Must wear closed toe non slip sneakers, no sandals.
- **Social Security Number** - Approximately seven days after you check into the program you will apply for a social security card. You will be able to work before you receive your card but you must provide a receipt to prove you have applied.

Housing and Transportation: (all photos below are example only for reference)

- **Overview of housing situation:** Assigned upon arrival in sponsor approved housing in West OC or OC. Located in motel/trailer/cottage/apartment style housing. Expect one bed per person (bunk bed style), micro/fridge, full bathroom.
- **Housing Fees:** Expect a seasonal rental fee between \$1900 and \$2100.
- **Additional Housing Fees:** Housing deposit of \$250 to be paid 4 weeks in advance with your first rental payment of \$250. \$200 of your deposit is eligible for refund upon successful program completion, damage inspection, and positive rental obligation standing. \$50 is a non-refundable admin fee.
 - **A total of 4 equal seasonal rent payments will be due in the USA prior to your 10th week on program.**
Payment schedule: 4 payments to be made: 1 in week 3, 1 in week 5, 1 in week 7, and 1 in week 9.
- **Transportation** – You will walk/bike/ride share to and from work each day. Public transportation into Ocean City can be utilized for \$3.00 per day. All transportation is your financial responsibility.
- **Bike Safety Reminder** – Always wear a helmet & reflective gear, utilize a blinking light, and obey all traffic signs and lights!
